



## Woods Bagot named Interior Design Firm of the Year at the Commercial Interior Design Awards



Woods Bagot was named Interior Design Firm of the Year at the annual CID Awards, which took place on November 11 at the Park Hyatt Dubai. The judging panel singled Woods Bagot out for continuing to create "design of the highest quality, originality and innovativeness". The judges also commended Woods Bagot for our "diversity and breadth".

After accepting the award, Duncan Parkinson said: "It's been a massive year for Woods Bagot. Regionally, from Africa to India, the Middle East and elsewhere, across hotel design, office interiors etc, we've been doing lots of stuff. The interiors market has been quite strong."

The CID Awards were designed to pay tribute to the companies and individuals currently shaping the Middle East urban environment. Entries received for the 2010 awards program include hotels in Makkah, offices in Libya and hospitals in Bahrain, and organisers said the entries were very representative of the region's interior design industry as a whole.

Duncan concluded: "This is the most prestigious award of the year - we consider the CID Awards to be the most important interior design awards in the Middle East. We do think this is the best one, and winning is great!"
